NARRATIVE  
 On September 01, 2015, this officer was requested to return back to the station by Hocking College Dispatch in reference to a female individual wanting to speak with an officer. Upon arrival to the station, I spoke with the female, later identified as [redacted] asked [redacted] what happened and she stated that she went to Ohio University to go to a CRU event. She saw someone she went to high school with, later identified as [redacted] was unable to give a last name. She stated she went with [redacted] to a party, where she "I drank a lot." [redacted] stated she somehow ended up back at Hocking College. She stated that she lost her keys, so she approached a group of individuals asking them if they could let her back into her [redacted] room. She stated that she did not remember anything else until she woke up the next morning and was in [redacted] room. When she woke up in [redacted] there were five [redacted] males there with her, and that the five males did not have any clothes on.  
 I asked [redacted] she could remember which room she was in? She stated that she knew it was [redacted] but did not know the room number or [redacted] (later determined to be on the [redacted])  
 I asked if she remembered any of the individuals? She stated they were all [redacted] and that they were [redacted] I asked [redacted] how much alcohol she had consumed? She stated she didn't know, that all she knows is that she drank four solo, plastic cups full of alcohol. She stated she did not know what it was that she was drinking, she had never had alcohol before. I asked [redacted] to tell me what she remembered, prior to not remembering anything. She stated she remembers walking back towards the [redacted] with the group of people. She stated she approached this group of people because there were some girls in the group. As they walked towards [redacted] most of the group left and there were only five male individuals. [redacted] stated one of the male individuals said he lived [redacted] but left his student identification card in a room [redacted]  
 I asked what [redacted] she went to in the [redacted] She stated she assumed it was on the [redacted] because she did not remember walking up stairs to get to the room. [redacted] explained that they entered through the [redacted] door [redacted] I asked [redacted] if she remembered any of the individual's names? She stated that she did not, that she could only remember a nickname and another [redacted]

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name, . I asked how she got back to campus from OU? She stated that she had no idea. She stated she was referred to our department by the advocacy center. stated she spoke with the Counseling Center here at Hocking College, who referred her to the Advocacy Center. She stated that she was under the assumption that she gave the five male individuals consent. I asked why did she felt that way? She stated she had never been with a guy before and that she came from a very strict environment. She stated that if she would give consent to one guy while she was not under the influence of alcohol, she would probably give consent to five guys while under the influence of alcohol.

I asked if had any of the clothes she was wearing that night? She stated she had already washed the clothing. stated she was wearing blue Jean shorts and a black tank top.

I asked to start over from the beginning. She stated she left from Hocking College to go to a CRU event with was unable to provide last name. She stated there was a group of people that went with them. I asked if lived on campus? She stated no, that stated that they went to Ohio University and got out of the vehicle and she saw She stated she and went to a party and she drank a lot. She stated she lost and he must have found her again. She stated he took her home because he was level headed and she was not. She stated she got back to Hocking and could not find her keys so she approached a group of individuals. One of the males in the group stated he lived in but left his ID in She stated that over half the group dropped off. She stated she ended up in the .. and didn't remember what the room number was. She had a plastic cup of Pepsi and then she woke up at approximately 4:00 - 4:30 a.m. without her clothes on. She got dressed and left. I asked if she remembered walking downstairs? She stated she does not remember walking up stairs when she got there, but did remember walking down stairs when she left. End of the first interview.

I asked to go through the event one more time? I asked who she left with? She stated she left campus with people in CRU. She stated she left with and a group of people. She stated they went to OU and she broke away from the group to talk to a guy. They went to a party and she got drunk. I asked if she consumed beer or liquor? She stated she did not know, that someone handed her a cup and told her to drink it. She stated her biggest assumption was that the guy found her again and took her back to her She lost her keys and needed to get back into her She approached a group and asked if anyone could let her into her She stated a male individual stated he could but had to go back to to get his ID. She stated she ended up with five guys in the in a room. She stated they turned off the light and she was drinking Pepsi. She then woke up at 4:00 a.m. and everyone had their clothes off. She stated she did not remember walking up steps but she might have walked down a few steps to leave. She stated she remembers walking past a bathroom and after that. I asked where she exited? She stated she exited

I asked how she got back into her She stated someone was outside the building and let her in. I advised that I was confused why she feels she would have agreed to having sex with the individuals. She stated she thinks she just doesn't want to wrap her head around someone taking advantage of her. I asked if she drank anything while she was in the She stated no, no alcohol. I asked if she could give me the list of names again? She stated

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asked if she could give a description of She stated  
 was willing to fill out a voluntary statement in reference  
 to everything she just told me. I asked if she had any marks or bruises on her person from the  
 incident? She stated she had some pain in her shoulders but nothing now. I asked if she  
 could remember if she said no anytime during the incident? She stated she was in the room and she  
 knows when she woke up she hurt really, really bad. But she must of had to, but did not remember. I  
 asked where she hurt at? She stated her thighs and her shoulders.

I advised of the Counseling Center here on Campus and that there are people here she can  
 talk to. During the first interview stated she spoke with a counselor here at Hocking College,  
 by the name of stated referred her to the Advocacy Center.

I then advised Chief A.L. Matthews of the incident. Chief A.L. Matthews then contacted Keller J.  
 Blackburn of the Athens County Prosecutors office and referred the case to their office.

Keller J. Blackburn and his staff arrived here at the Hocking College Police station and took over the  
 investigation.

Mr. Blackburn's investigators were able to determine that the room number in  
 where the incident occurred was Ofc. Eskey sealed the room and made sure  
 no one came in or out of it.

I escorted Investigator Tom McKnight to the Athens County Court house where he met with Judge  
 Robert Stewart who signed the search warrant for

After arriving back on Campus, we were met by a BCI Agent, Stephanie A. Herron. We then escorted  
 Ms. Herron to the room listed on the search warrant. Ofc. Eskey and I stood outside the door and  
 guarded the evidence Agent Herron collected. While Mr. Blackburn and his investigators continued their  
 investigation.

All evidence that was collected from being stored in  
 HCPD evidence room. A copy of the search warrant and other documentation Mr. Blackburns office  
 collected have been placed in the case file.
